REFURBISHMENT AND EXTENSION OF MONKS AND DEANS BUILDING

The project involved the refurbishment and extension of the monks and deans buildings at the college. Sections of the building remained in use and a tight schedule of phased works was put in place to ensure an efficient project with minimal disruption.

The project used a wide variety of LED lighting, specialist controls and energy monitoring solutions to bring the vibrant college area up to date with the needs of the students. The revitalized areas contain the new administration centre for the college, as well as the student libraries and the common rooms, along with student support. The newly built top floor also contains the new I.T suites enabling a central location for computer studies.

The external plaza was renewed with an extensive decorative LED lighting scheme installed by brook and mayo to enliven the open spaces around the new college area.

The project took 36 weeks to complete, was electrically completed to program. Since finishing the works, Brook and mayo have continued to provide maintenance services to the college and have built a solid long term working relationship.
